Read: Share books together!

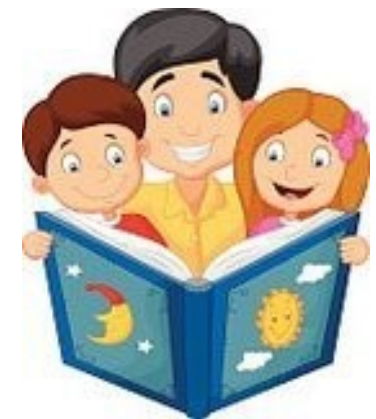
Write: Scribble, draw and make tactile art.
